- Concern re: closure of Summit Elementary; next year Mission will focus on 7-12 at MSS; if in elementary, will fall under provincial hubs (i.e. Abbotsford, Maple Ridge etc).

Superintendent's Report: Angus Wilson

- a. Lot of bargaining days with CUPE; not much time spent elsewhere (clarification are in negotiations; not favouring/advocating for one side or the other).
- b. Snow day

Reasonably well run; experienced treacherous roads himself.

- c. <u>Safe schools meeting had to be cancelled due to snowstorm (will be rescheduled be area of concern (i.e. proto gangs).</u>
- d. More flight team training

String of unfortunate incidents with students or recently graduated has been difficult for teachers/staff.

e. Spent time at end of school day observing HPMS and Windebank

Noticed children darting across roads at end of school day – some to catch city bus.

City looking at timing of traffic lights; also changed timing of bus.

Also concern re: reliance on vehicles – leads to far more cars/trucks on/around school property.

- Another project for the new year.

Chair's Report: Jacquelyn Wickham

a. Nov 22 – attended BC Communities Ending Poverty Community of Practice meeting

Discussed daily living wage; various organizations united to provide advocacy and inform policy and help to set thresholds.

A family defined as 2 parents both working FT, two kids 4 and 7.

FV has lowest required liveable daily wage; one of highest was Golden, BC.

Biggest cost increase in medical cost; lowest increase in childcare.

Changed to better reflect renters; factors in additional costs of renters having to move etc rather than average rents. Also recognized shifting costs associated with transportation across different areas.

- *Noted: 25% of renters had to move in last 12mos – speaks to vulnerability.*

b. <u>COTW meeting</u>

SOGI rep spoke about work – push for intersectionality, need for safe space in bathrooms.

Discussed completion rates; went up this year (yay!).

District working on new indigenous course re: relationship to land; not yet approved, going forward to Board tomorrow.

Some push to reduce # of teachers students are shuffling between; also rise in vandalism in school (esp. bathrooms).
